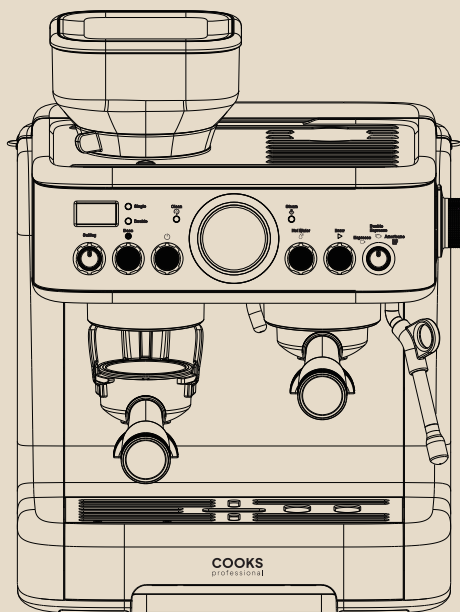

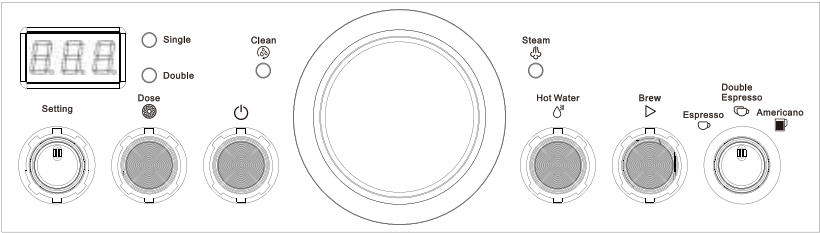
- **Read all instructions carefully** before using the appliance.

- **Allow the machine to cool completely** before disassembling or cleaning any parts.
- **Operate the appliance on a stable, flat surface.** Ensure it is positioned away from edges to prevent tipping.

ADDITIONAL SAFETY INFORMATION

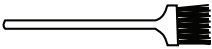
- The power cord is intentionally designed to be short to reduce the risk of tripping or entanglement.

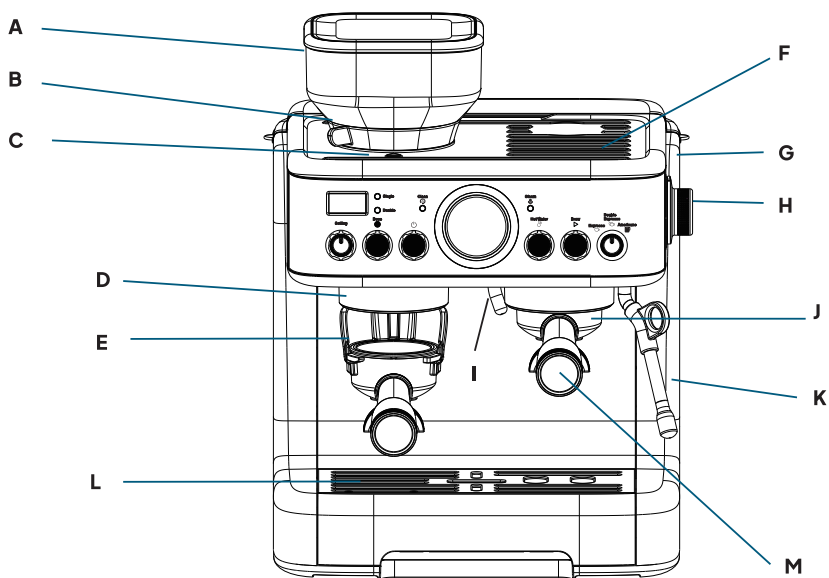

	Power Button	Press the Power button to turn the machine on. To activate the cleaning mode, press and hold the button for 5 seconds.		Setting Knob	Rotate the Setting knob left or right to adjust functions such as time, temperature, and water volume. Press the knob to confirm your selection and move to the next setting option.
	Dose Button	When the machine is powered on, press the Dose button to select the desired coffee volume: single cup or double cup.		Hot Water Button	Hot water cannot be dispensed during preheating. Once preheating is complete, press the Hot Water button to start the hot water function. Press the button again to stop the flow.
	Coffee selection knob	This three-position knob allows you to choose your coffee type: • Left - Single espresso • Middle - Double espresso • Right - Americano Note: Once the Brew button is pressed, this knob will be temporarily disabled.		Brew Button	After selecting your desired coffee type using the Coffee Selection Knob, press the Brew button to begin brewing.
	Steam Knob	After the machine has finished preheating, turn the Steam knob to begin steam preheating. The steam indicator light will flash during this process. When the light stops flashing and is illuminated, steam will automatically be released. To stop the steam, turn the Steam knob back to the off position. If not manually turned off, the steam function will stop automatically after 2 minutes. Important: The Steam knob must be manually turned off before the steam function can be used again.		LED Screen	• In Grind Mode, displays the grinding time • In Brew Mode, displays the brewing time • In Hot Water Mode, shows the water temperature (default: 80°C)

COMPONENTS



Machine Components:

- A 280g Bean hopper
- B Grind size selector
- C Integrated conical burr grinder
- D Grind outlet
- E Grinding cradle
- F Cup warmer
- G 2.6L Water tank
- H Steam dial
- I Hot water outlet
- J Group head
- K Steam wand
- L Drip tray
- M Portafilter

SETUP & INSTALLATION

1. Clean the water tank before first use.
2. Fill with water do not exceed the 'MAX' line.
3. Insert the tank securely until it clicks into place.

Tip: Ideally use filtered tap water – unfiltered can affect taste and lead to limescale. Refresh daily for best results.

BEAN HOPPER

1. Clean the bean hopper before use.
2. Align the 'unlock' icon on the hopper with the matching icon on the machine.
3. Rotate counter-clockwise until you hear a click and the 'lock' icon aligns.
4. Fill with fresh, whole coffee beans. Do not use pre-ground coffee.
5. Ensure the internal hopper gate switch is facing forward (open) before grinding.
6. Before removing the hopper, turn the switch to close the bean chute – this prevents beans spilling out.

If the bean hopper is not installed correctly, grinding will be disabled. The dose button light will turn red to reflect this.

GRINDING FUNCTION

Using the Grinder

- The machine defaults to single-shot grind mode.
- The Single Shot light will illuminate and the LED screen displays the grind time.
- Press the Dose button to toggle between Single and Double mode (light will update accordingly).

Grinding Your Beans

1. Insert the portafilter into the grind cradle.
2. The machine detects the portafilter and automatically starts grinding.
3. The dosing light illuminates and the digital screen begins the countdown.
4. When the time ends, grinding stops automatically.
5. You can pause mid-grind by removing the portafilter – reinserting it resumes grinding from the remaining time.



ADJUSTING GRIND TIME

Default Grind Time is 7 seconds for Single and 14 seconds for Double

1. Select Single or Double Shot via the Dose button.
2. Rotate the Setting Knob to choose a grind time (0–30 seconds).
3. Press the Setting Knob again to save and exit.

You will need to dial in the machine to suit your chosen coffee beans. Bean grind will vary according to specific variety, roast and freshness.

High quality fresh beans will produce the best results.

HOT WATER FUNCTION

Dispensing Hot Water

- Available after the machine has fully preheated.
- Press the Hot Water button to begin dispensing hot water. The light flashes white and the digital display shows 80°C. This is the default hot water temperature.
- Press Hot Water again to stop.

The Brew button is disabled during hot water use.

CUSTOMISING HOT WATER SETTINGS

1. After preheating, press and hold the Hot Water button for 3 seconds.
2. **Volume Setting:**
 - Brew & Setting lights flash.
 - Screen displays 100ml (default).
 - Adjust using the Setting Knob (50–200ml).
 - Press the Setting Knob to confirm.
3. **Temperature Setting:**
 - Screen displays 80°C (default).
 - Adjust with Setting Knob (60–85°C).
 - Press the Setting Knob to confirm and exit.



BREW FUNCTION

Brewing Espresso or Americano

- Once the machine is fully preheated, Brew and Hot Water lights will illuminate.
- Use the Coffee Selection Knob to choose:
Left: Single Espresso
Middle: Double Espresso
Right: Americano
- Press the Brew button to start brewing.
- The LED display shows a countdown timer.

ESPRESSO SETTINGS (Single/Double)

To customise espresso settings:

1. Select Single or Double espresso on the Coffee Selection Knob.
2. Press and hold the Brew button for 3 seconds.

Setting Sequence (displayed in LED screen):

1. Pre-Infusion Time
 - Default: 3 sec (range: 0–10 sec)
2. Pre-Infusion Water Volume
 - Default: 15ml (Single), 20ml (Double) (range: 10–80ml)
3. Brew Volume
 - Default: 35ml (Single), 75ml (Double) (range: 20–200ml)
4. Brew Temperature
 - Default: 92°C (range: 88–96°C)

Use the Setting Knob to adjust each step, pressing to confirm and move to the next.



AMERICANO SETTINGS

To customise Americano brewing settings:

1. Select Americano on the Coffee Selection Knob.
2. Press and hold the Brew button for 3 seconds.

Setting Sequence:

1. Pre-Infusion Time (range: 0–10 sec)
2. Pre-Infusion Water Volume (range: 10–80ml)
3. Espresso Brew Volume (range: 5–200ml)
4. Espresso Brew Temperature (range: 88–96°C)
5. Americano Water Volume
 - Default: 100ml (range: 50–200ml)
6. Americano Water Temperature
 - Default: 80°C (range: 60–85°C)

Follow prompts, use the Setting Knob to adjust, and press to confirm each setting.

CLEANING FUNCTION

After 500 espresso extractions, the Cleaning light flashes white.

To clean:

1. Power off the machine.
2. Add a suitable descaling agent to the water tank.
3. Press and hold the Power button for 5 seconds.
4. The machine flushes:
 - Hot Water System
 - Brew Group
 - Steam Circuit
5. The machine returns to standby and resets the counter.

Run another cycle with clean water to flush out descaling solution residue.

You can cancel mid-cleaning by pressing the Power button (but it won't reset the counter).

TROUBLESHOOTING & ERROR CODES

Issue	Description	Solution
NTC Sensor Fault	Red Power light for 0.5s + long buzzer	Contact customer support
Missing Bean Hopper	Dose button glows red, grinding disabled	Reinstall hopper correctly
Overtemperature Alert	Hot Water, Brew & Coffee Selection lights flash red	Press Hot Water to flush and cool boiler for 10 seconds. Machine is cooled again when lights turn white.
Water Tank Empty	Hot Water & Brew lights flash red	Refill water tank

FACTORY RESET

- To restore all settings:
- Press and hold the Dose, Hot Water, and Brew buttons simultaneously for 3 seconds.
 - The machine will beep to confirm reset.

Wires are coloured as follows:

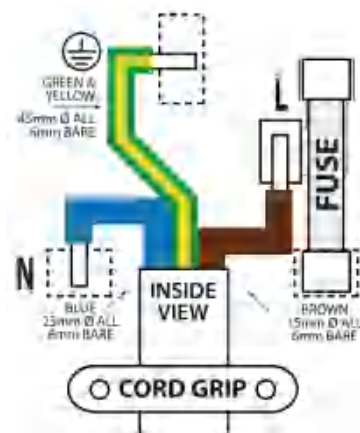
Brown – Live

Blue – Neutral

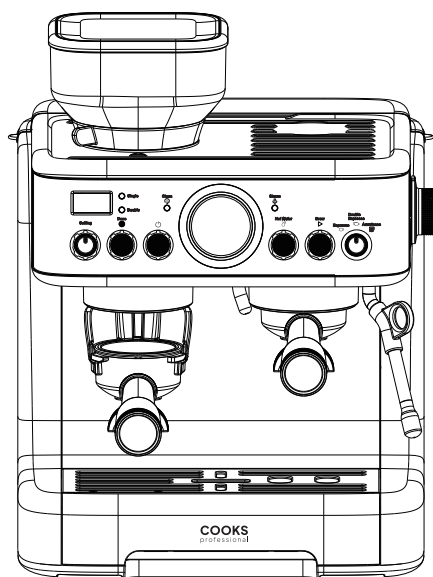
Yellow & Green – Earth

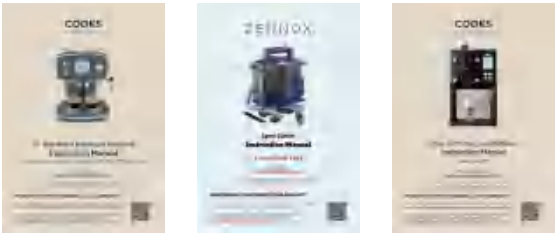

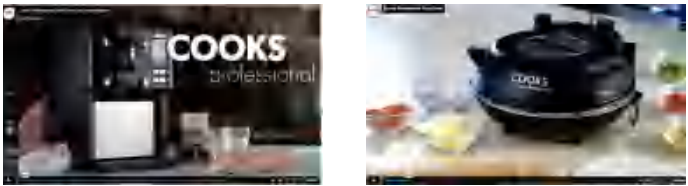
